Following graduation, she pursued her interest in

She is a part-time Assistant Professor at Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC where she instructs and directs courses in Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology to post-doctoral residents of Oral Surgery, Endodontics, Periodontics and Prosthodontics as well as pre-doctoral dental students and hygiene students. She is also a volunteer attending at LAC+USC Medical Center where she consults with medical pathologists on oral pathology cases. Dr. Boros also has an oral medicine practice in Santa Monica. In her spare time, she enjoys spending time with her family and friends, traveling, and maintains an active lifestyle.

Parish P. Sedghizadeh, D.D.S., M.S.



In addition to consulting for Oral Pathology Associates, Dr. Parish P. Sedghizadeh is a full-time Assistant Clinical Professor at the University of Southern California (USC), Ostrow School of Dentistry, and Director of the USC Center for Biofilms. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in biology from UCLA and his DDS from

USC. After his doctorate, he pursued specialty training in Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology at The Ohio State University, where he also attained a MS in oral biology, fellowship in the Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology and subsequently board certification. Dr. Sedghizadeh conducts research, publishes, consults and teaches oral and maxillofacial pathology, radiology and medicine with an active clinical practice. Dr. Sedghizadeh has over 80 peer-reviewed publications, and his research laboratory, clinical practice and clinical research projects at USC currently focus on the characterization and treatment of head and neck pathology and microbial biofilm infections, particularly jaw osteomyelitis and osteonecrosis where he has developed novel bone-targeted antimicrobial therapeutics.

Course Description:

This 6 hour CE course includes both lecture format and a case-based approach to review common and less common, but very significant oral and maxillofacial lesions. The goal of this course is to provide dental hygienists, general dentists, dental specialists and medical professionals with the knowledge and tools necessary to detect and manage a wide range of oral and maxillofacial conditions. A broad range of topics will be presented including recently described malignancies, common oral conditions, HPV-related diseases, oral manifestations of systemic disease and odontogenic tumors. An emphasis will be placed on clinically relevant information with a focus on lesion detection, diagnostics including potential pitfalls, and patient management.

Course Objectives:

At the conclusion of this course, the participant should understand the importance of performing a comprehensive oral examination, master an approach to formulating differential diagnoses based on clinical and/or radiographic findings and gain knowledge and confidence in appropriate management of patients with oral conditions. This translates clinically to the practitioner providing comprehensive overall oral health care.
